630 warm meals were distributed to residents of the maternity home.

On an average, Room at the Inn of the Triad provides seven mothers and

children a place to stay every night all month and serves 21 meals a day.

The residents hosted and prepared their own yard sale this month. It was

unfortunately not a very good turn out because of weather, but they learned a lot by the experience of organizing and in promotion of an event.

- ◆ Another has moved into her apartment and will be returning to work and taking classes at UNCG in the fall.

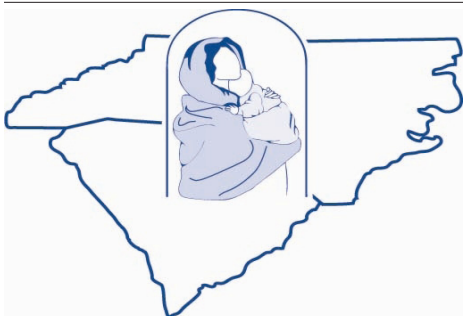
