#### **Administrative and Management Standards**

Ethical Practice (ETH), Financial Management (FIN), Governance (GOV) or Administration & Management (AM) (for Public State Systems), Human Resources (HR), Performance and Quality Improvement (PQI), Risk Prevention and Management (RPM)

- ETH The organization adheres to a strong, consistent code of ethics that ensures trustworthiness and accountability. There is an effective fundraising program that continues to show positive growth in generating revenue.
- FIN The organization has sound financial procedures that provide management and the board with accurate financial information so they can ensure the organization operates as efficiently and effectively as possible. There is an adequate segregation of duties. The organization utilizes an independent audit committee.
- GOV The board is knowledgeable about the organization and active in fulfilling its roles related to fundraising, policy development, PQI, risk management, and financial oversight. Board members expressed confidence in the CEO and his management of the organization based on what they describe as an open and honest working relationship.
- HR The organization consistently has employees sign appropriate policy forms annually and they receive annual training on those policies. Performance evaluations are also completed annually. New employees participate in a comprehensive orientation process. The staff described the culture of the organization as mission driven and client focused. It is a nurturing, supportive team environment.
- PQI This organization has a well-developed and fully implemented PQI program that appropriately involves its various stakeholders. PQI activities are included on agendas and documented. Summary reports are compiled. The organization tracks outcomes in both its service programs and its administrative operations.
- RPM The organization is doing a good job of risk prevention and management from intake through discharge, as well as ensuring that staff and clients are safe and protected within its capabilities. The organization has a well packaged risk prevention and

management system in place that enables it to reduce risk, loss, and liability exposure. Their good record thus far is a prime example of the effectiveness of their risk management efforts.

## **Service Delivery Administration Standards**

Administrative and Service Environment (ASE), Behavior Support and Management (BSM), Client Rights (CR), Training and Supervision (TS)

- ASE The facilities reflect the organization's commitment to adequately cater to the needs of the population it serves. The facilities emphasize the dignity and worth of all individuals. Comments made by those being served consistently emphasize the influence and impact the organization has made on their lives.
- BSM It is laudable that the staff members are able to manage the different needs of those who come into the program and are able to provide rehabilitative services that meet the varying needs of each resident. The behavior modification program is great and they are able to provide structure and direction to residents at their point of greatest need.
- CR The organization has a great focus on client rights, including clients' right to dignity and to feel self-worth.
- TS The training plan is comprehensive and staff members report having the opportunity to request training as needed, in addition to the extensive internal training program. Funding is specifically allocated for training and staff development in the annual budget.

#### **Service Standards**

- GLS The organization provides quality services to clients. The services are much needed in the community. The organization operates well and is managed very well. Clients receive services that are appropriate to their needs in a well-structured and safe environment.
- GSS The After Care Program provides helpful ongoing material and referral support to clients who complete the maternity home program including ways for clients to maintain connection to the organization through Facebook and quarterly group meetings.
- SCL The organization provides an excellent temporary residential opportunity post or prior to admittance to the maternity home. This gives residents and their babies who do not have alternative housing upon completion of the maternity home program somewhere to live while they wait for housing. Service provision in this program is great.
